Often, housing and other needs of these adults are met by their families, the State of Connecticut or by agencies that operate private programming models funded by the State (approximately 150 licensed providers in Connecticut).

As the population of adults with special needs expands and legacy services are phasing out, we anticipate a shortage of appropriate residential options. We know parents are very concerned about the future living arrangements of their adult child with special needs and parents are examining their alternatives.
