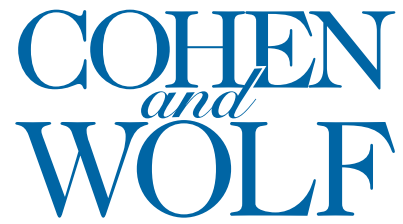

The Connecticut Child Support Guidelines are published by the Connecticut Commission for Child Support Guidelines pursuant to Connecticut General Statute 46b-215a. The Commission is required to meet within every four years to revise and update the Connecticut Child Support Guidelines.

Ms. Pencu is an attorney in Cohen and Wolf's Family Law and Litigation Groups. In addition to serving on the Commission, Ms. Pencu serves as a Special Master, appointed by the Superior Court, to mediate divorce disputes in the judicial district of Bridgeport. She is admitted to practice in Connecticut and is a member of the American, Connecticut Fairfield County and Greater Bridgeport Bar Associations. She previously served as Chair of the Bridgeport Local Unit for the CBA Young Lawyers Section.
